

## **TOWN OF HOLDEN PARKING ORDINANCE**

**ARTICLE I. TITLE:** This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the Town of Holden Parking Ordinance.

**ARTICLE II. AUTHORITY:** This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Title 30-A, Section 3001 of the Maine Revised Statutes Annotated.

**ARTICLE III. PURPOSE:** This ordinance is designed to control parking within the Town of Holden. The Municipal Officers shall maintain suitable parking signs and markings indicating time, manner, and place of parking motor vehicles in accordance with this ordinance. No person shall park motor vehicles contrary to this ordinance and such signs and/or markings.

### **ARTICLE IV. DEFINITIONS:**

1. Municipal Officers: Municipal Officers shall mean the Board of Selectmen.
2. Parked: The word "parked" used in this ordinance shall mean allowing a motor vehicle remain stationary in a high-way, public way, public parking area or street, whether attended or unattended.
3. Automobile: "Automobile" shall mean a motor vehicle designed for the conveyance of passengers with seating capacity of not more than 14 persons.
4. Motor Truck: "Motor truck" shall mean any vehicle designed and used for the conveyance of property, and or passengers.
5. Motorcycle: "Motorcycle" shall mean every motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than 3 wheels in contact with the ground, but excluding a tractor and a parking control vehicle.
6. Motor Vehicle: When the word "motor vehicle" is used in the ordinance, it is intended to encompass the types of vehicles defined in Section 3,4, and 5.

### **ARTICLE V. PARKING PROHIBITED:**

1. No motor vehicle shall be parked on the north side of Maine Road (Route 1A) from the intersection of Maine Road (Route 1A) from the intersection of Main Road (Route 1A) and the Bagaduce Road to a point 600 feet west of said intersection;
2. No motor vehicle shall be parked on the north side of Maine road (Route 1A) between utility pole #329-3 and a point 600 feet west of pole #329-3 (across from the Holden General Store).

**ARTICLE VI. PENALTY:** Any person violating this ordinance shall pay to the Town, a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor greater than \$100.00.

**ARTICLE VII. EFFECTIVE DATE:** This ordinance shall become effective on the date of adoption by the Board of Selectmen.
